STELLA BOYLE SMITH, for whom the competition is named, was born in Farmingto n, MO, into a large, musically-inclined family, that later moved to AR. Her second husband, George Smith, had various business interests which allowed them to engage in philanthropy. A pianist, Smith's love for music inspired her to start the Musical Group in 1923 in Little Rock where she lived until her death in 1994. Initially established as an educational tool for children, the group became the A rkansas Symphony Orchestra Guild in 1966.
